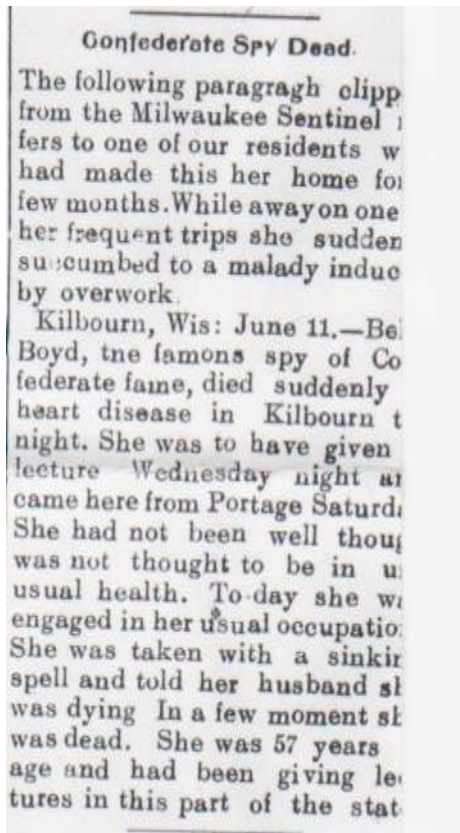


Belle Boyd Visits Evansville
